

Brief report of the functioning of Sree Narayana College during 2018-19

The classes for the academic year 2018-19 began on June 1, 2018. A meeting of the College Council was convened to discuss the plan of action for the year. Academic calendar was prepared and the Teachers' work diary was distributed to all teachers like in the previous years.

Presently, there are 65 teaching staff members (15 males and 50 females), of which 36 possess Ph.D. as their highest degree, 9 with M.Phil degree and 23 Post-graduates.

Admissions to the UG and PG courses this academic year were carried out by the online procedure of the University. The student strength for the year was 1874 (610 males and 1264 females) for UG courses and 99 (15 males and 83 females) for PG courses. The first year students of all classes were given an orientation about the rules and regulations to be followed in the college and various aspects regarding their course of study during the "Know Your College" programme organized by the IQAC on 7th November 2018.

Noteworthy achievements of the college during the academic year 2018-19 are listed below:

- ✓ In the final year UG examinations during April/May 2018, **Arsha Hari** of III B.Com and **Sumayya Subbair** of III B.Sc. Psychology secured third rank in the Kerala University.
- ✓ **Dr. K. R. Kavitha**, Assistant Professor, Dept. Of Botany, has been nominated as a **member of the Syndicate, University of Kerala**.
- ✓ **Dr Swapna Gopinath**, Associate Professor, Department of English, has been selected for the **UGC Research Award** for completing Post-doctoral research during 2016-18. She is also selected for the **Fulbright Research and Excellence Fellowship for 2019-20** from India, to pursue research at The University of Rochester, USA.
- ✓ **Dr. Regi S R**, Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology, received the "**Best Paper Award**" from the Chief Minister of Utharakhand, in the three-day **International Biodiversity Congress** held at Dehradun from 04 to 06 October 2018.
- ✓ **Dr. Ambili Raj D. B.**, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry, received Teachers Associateship for Research Excellence (TARE) by DST-SERB.

- ✓ **Dr.Uthara Soman**, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology, is the Secretary of the Kerala Sociological Society.
- ✓ **Dhanya S. R.**, Assistant Professor, Department of Mathematics and **Vaisakh S. S.**, Guest Faculty, Department of Chemistry were awarded Ph.D. during this academic year.
- ✓ **Swapna O.**, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce, and **Raji Ravindran**, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics submitted their Ph.D theses to University of Kerala this year.
- ✓ Five research students, working under the supervision of faculty of our college, submitted their Ph.D. theses this year.
- ✓ Fifteen teachers attended Refresher/Orientation/Short term courses during 2018-19. Teachers actively engaged in research activities and attended various seminars/workshop/conferences.
- ✓ The students, teachers and P.T.A of the college exhibited their social commitment by actively participating and contributing to the **flood relief activities** and by contributing to the **Ockhi fund**. The NSS Unit of our college undertook several missions “Kuttanadinoru Kaithangu” and “Trivandrum Flood Relief” and lent their support by providing funds and supply of relief items to the worst affected areas of the state. The NCC cadets also actively participated in the flood relief activities.
- ✓ Sree Narayana College, Chempazhanthy, hosted **Sasthrajalakam** programme, an initiative by the General Education Department and the State Institute of Education Technology (SIET) this year.
- ✓ **Spectrum 2019**, the annual academic seminar series of the college was organised from 27th February 2019 to 12th March 2019.
- ✓ All clubs and committees of the college actively functioned during the year. Most of the commemorative days and days of international significance were celebrated in the college. World Environment Day, National Science Day, World Ozone day, and World Wetlands day were celebrated with the financial assistance of KSCSTE. Christmas was celebrated by all teachers and students.

College Union elections were held in the parliamentary mode during 2018-19. Vishnu Prasad of II B.Sc Mathematics was elected as the Chairman of the College Union. The College Union actively functioned for the benefit of all students and many programs were organized by the

Union in this academic year. There was an appreciable participation from the college for the Kerala University Youth Festival held at Kariavattom on March 2019. Rohini.M (II M.A English) bagged 4 first prizes and two second prizes for various competitions. Bhadra Sharma E (I B.Sc. Psychology) won first prize for Sanskrit recitation in the University Youth Festival.

- ✓ The activities of the NSS volunteers and NCC cadets were very commendable and brought wide publicity to the college in print and electronic media. The NSS unit engaged in organic forming in the campus.
- ✓ A majority of the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college contributed their service to the Nation as Polling Officials in the Loksabha Elections held on 23rd April 2019.

The Principal, teaching and non-teaching staff, and the students acknowledge the support received from the Management in all facets of development of our college.

Report of the Major Events of 2018-19

SASTHRAJALAKAM 2018-19

Sree Narayana College, Chempazhanthy was proud to co-ordinate the Sasthrajalakam programme, a new initiative by the General Education Department and the State Institute of Education Technology (SIET) from January 5th to 7th, 2019. It was a joint venture organised for the scientific enrichment of the 9th standard students from various government schools.

The programme was inaugurated on January 5th, 2019 by the Hon. Devaswom, Tourism and Co-operation Minister, Sri. Kadakampally Surendran at 11 am in the College Seminar Hall. Thirty one students from various Govt. Schools of Thiruvananthapuram district, provisionally selected based on the Talent hunt conducted by the SIET were registered to participate in the second phase of Sasthrajalakam held in the college. The inauguration started with the prayer. The inaugural ceremony was welcomed by, Dr. S. R. Jitha, Principal, Sree Narayana College, Chempazhanthy. The function was presided over by the Director of SIET, Sri. Aburaj, who explained the needs, deeds, aims and functions of SIET. The keynote address was delivered by Prof. V. P. Mahadevan Pillai, Vice Chancellor, Kerala University, who explained the science behind every natural phenomenon. Felicitations were given by Dr. Kavitha K. R., Syndicate Member, University of Kerala; Dr. P. S. Anjana, District co-ordinator of Sasthrajalakam 2018-19; and Dr. Raakhee A. S., IQAC Co-ordinator. As a token of appreciation, mementos were presented to our guests, Sri. Kadakampally Surendran and Prof. V. P. Mahadevan Pillai. The vote of thanks was proposed by Ms. Aswathy S. P., Asst. Prof in Chemistry (Programme Co-ordinator, Sasthrajalakam 2018-19).

A technical session was given by Dr. Sibi K. S., Asst. Prof in Physics, University of Kerala, Kariyavattom Campus. He started his session with the Earth Song, composed by the King of Pop – Michael Jackson. He explained the basics of Electronics and various innovative technologies. After this session, lunch was provided for the students.

In the afternoon, the students were taken to the Geology class, where the Resource Person, Smt. L. Neena, Associate Professor in Geology, S N College, Chempazhanthy explained the origin of earth and genesis through Powerpoint presentation. The students were fascinated by the class and cleared many doubts regarding the topic. They were taken to the Chemistry Lab for practical sessions. The students were grouped in to 8 batches and conducted various experiments including chromatography, acid-base

titration, various chemical reactions etc. The chemistry practical session was co-ordinated by Dr. Ambili Raj D. B., Asst. Prof in Chemistry, S N College,, Chempazhanthy, who was assisted by the UG and PG students of our Chemistry Department.

The students were then taken to the seminar hall for a documentary show related to the topic “Necessity of scientific innovation in human development”. The students actively participated in the debate “Science and the Human Kind” and stated the various positives and negatives. The first day’s sessions ended by 7.30 pm and the students were then taken to the hostel, Sikshak Sadan, Kumarapuram,.

The second day of the camp (6th January) started with the technical session “Sarvam Rasathantaramayam” by Dr. Vaisakh S. S., Asst. Prof in Chemistry, S N College, Chempazhanthy. He explained the chemistry behind everyday life and various applications and opportunities in chemistry. He exposed the danger behind the fast food life we are going through and their remedial/preventive measures. The second session was handled by Dr. S. Renjith, Scientist B, SCTIMST, who explained the basics of general chemistry including the atomic model, their formulation, etc.

The next technical session was handled by Dr. Regi. S. R., Asst. Prof in Zoology, S N College, Chempazhanthy. He explained the values of Biodiversity. He also showed some interesting documentary videos regarding the topic. The students were really enthusiastic and asked many perplexing questions.

In the afternoon session, the students were grouped into two batches and each batch was sent to Physics and Geology Lab simultaneously and vice versa. The various experiments in Physics lab were shown to the students by the faculty and UG students of the Physics Department. The overall session was monitored by the Resource person, Smt. Manu K. B., Asst. Prof in Physics, S N College, Chempazhanthy. At the same time, the Geology Department organised an outstanding exhibition containing various rocks, minerals, sediments, volcanoes and their origin etc. The students had a keen interest in asking questions due to their inevitable enthusiasm. Their enthusiasm for Geology exhibition was reflected in the feedback form also.

The students were taken to the campus to view our medicinal garden, organic farming maintained by our NSS volunteers and various other facilitation centres. After that, a short discussion regarding the career development was carried out by Dr. Suma S., Associate Professor in Chemistry, S N College, Chempazhanthy. The students were curious in getting information related to different careers they should opt in the future. All the sessions concluded by 7.30 pm.

The last day of the programme (7th January) started with the technical session carried by Prof. Shibu S., Associate Professor in Physics, S N College, and Chempazhanthy. The session explained the aberrant relationship between the man and the universe. The second session was handled by Dr. P. Biju, Asst. Prof in Botany, S N College, Varkala. The session dealt with the climatic change and its consequences. Each resource person of the technical sessions was welcomed by the student volunteers of our college.

The students were grouped into two batches and each batch was simultaneously sent to Zoology and Botany Lab and vice versa. Various species of plants and animals preserved in formalin, fossils, skeletons etc. were shown to the students. The Botany Department conducted many experiments including the Hydrilla experiment, which was monitored by Dr. Suma B. S., Associate Professor in Botany, S N College, Chempazhanthy, assisted by the UG students of Botany Department. The Zoology lab conducted a small exhibition and blood sugar test. They also exhibited a documentary show regarding the wide variety of animal species in our planet. Dr. Swapna S., Asst. Prof in Zoology, S N College, Chempazhanthy, was in charge of the Zoology lab who was assisted by the UG students of Zoology Department.

After the Biology lab sessions, there was a short session for collecting the feedback of students about the programme. Feedback forms were distributed and collected back and they were allowed time for interaction. A few of them expressed their positives and negatives in the stage itself.

The valedictory session was held at 2.30 pm in the College Seminar hall, which was presided over by Dr. S. R. Jitha, Principal, S N College, Chempazhanthy. The chief guest, parents and students were officially welcomed by Ms. Aswathy S. P., Programme Co-ordinator, Sasthrajalakam 2018-19. The keynote address was given by Dr. M. R. Yesodharan, Director of Sree Narayana International Study Centre. Prof. Shibu S., Head of the Department of Physics presented an overall report of the Sasthrajalakam programme held in our college. The certificates of the student participants were distributed by our Chief Guest. The vote of thanks was proposed by Smt. Jayasree K., Asst. Prof in Physics and the Convenor of Science club. The programme was concluded with the National Anthem.

SSP programme aims at imparting personalised academic support to needy students through tutorials, study materials, additional lectures, interactive sessions, and formation of quality circles in colleges for the programme, dissemination of classes through personal and Web based modes etc. The Government of Kerala had launched the Scholar support programme (SSP) in Aided Arts and Science College during 2013-2014.

The Programme started in our college during the academic year 2013-2014. The College successfully implemented the programme during the academic years 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017 etc. The programme successfully completed in the academic year 2018-2019 also. Both faculties and students provide their whole hearted support for the successful implementation.

As per the direction from the Office Of the New Initiatives, the college council selected a college level co-ordinator for the SSP programme. The scheme has been discussed in the college council and amongst faculty members. A college level monitoring committee shall be appointed by the college council. As student representatives, Mr. Vishnu L, First Year B.A. Political Science and Ms. Diya S, First year B.Sc Zoology has been selected. First year UG students are made to aware of the programme, selection of the students is done by the parent department. Students who have scored less than 60% / lower aggregate marks in the qualifying examination and who needs additional support are selected. Each class tutor assess the students through interactions and selected the students considering the factors like, learning difficulties, difficulties in memory, attention, need of emotional support etc.

Subjects selected

Based on university result analysis, five subjects selected giving equal importance to B.A and B.Sc programmes. The subjects selected were Political Science, Maths, History, Physics and Zoology. Eight students were selected from each subject. Total of 40 students are there in scholar Support Programme. Faculties those who are interested and dedicated to this programme from the respective departments provide classes. Students from maths department are provided with English Classes. A total of 35 classes were given in each semester. Classes for first semester has been started on 16.10.2018 and ended on 09.11.2018. A time table for first semester classes has been provided by the co-ordinator. Classes for second semester has started on 14.01.2019 and ended on 08.02.2019. Internal mentors were Dr. Regi.S.R (Zoology), Dr. Saritha SR (History), Sri. Appu AA (English), Sri, Abhilash S (Political Science) and Ms. Jayasree (Physics)

External Mentoring Classes

External Mentoring classes were provided in areas like, Life Skill, Learning Skill, IT Skill etc. Four classes (each 1hour duration) for learning skill are provided. Faculty from Psychology Department, Dr. AravindThampi, Assistant Professor and Consultant Psychologist and Dr. Rakhee A.S Assistant Professor were the external mentors. Thirty two hours of life Skill Classes were provided . Sri. Vishnu J Mohan from ASAP was the external mentor. Twenty four classes were provided for IT Skill. Sri. Subin K Varghese from Model Finishing School was the external mentor.

WALK WITH SCHOLAR REPORT 2018-2019

WWS program at SN College Chempazhanthy is being conducted with two batches of students, one for 1st and 2nd semester and the second for 3rd and 4th semesters. It has been continuing successfully since its inception in the university system. We began some of the highly successful programs –theatre workshops, manuscript magazines and so on.

During the year 2018-19 WWS program is being spearheaded by Ms Lakshmi AJ, Asst. Prof, Department of Commerce. The program has a total of 10 mentors who were selected after circulating a consent form among the members of the faculty. This democratic process was to ensure that mentors are truly committed to the programme.

Mentees were selected after a careful screening process that happened at two levels. Class tutors were asked to give a list and students were then asked to go through a screening process. Final selection was done after this process to ensure that the best of the candidates get the opportunity to be part of the process.

Mentor –Mentee interaction is ensured and an informal meeting schedule is maintained. External mentors were selected after discussion with the mentees. There were brainstorming sessions with the mentees to design a plan of action for the year ahead. It was decided to conduct the following programs.

As part of the introduction section our mentees from our passed out batch who are currently doing their post-graduation in TIS Mumbai, shared their experience and they also motivated their juniors.

External mentoring sessions began with sessions by Deepa Ananthapadmanabhan, a social entrepreneur based in Trivandrum, spearheading the organization called SARSAS, Save a Rupee, Spread a Smile. She held sessions for both bathes on 03/11/208.Her session focused on being socially responsible individuals and also extended her support and guidance to students in building their social leadership skills.

A session by Avaneesh, who runs the organization Mantastic in Trivandrum. He conducted Calligraphy workshops for both batches on 01/12/2018. We provided the participants with required pens and other stationery. As per request of the mentees Mr Avaneesh was invited for another motivational and interactive session on 09/02/2018 which was activity oriented. Pran of Prancare conducted workshops for the participants of both the batches on 08/12/2018. This was conducted for our second year mentees. Separate sessions were conducted for self improvement. His sessions were informative and self-reflective.

Another interesting programme was the 3-day Theatre Workshop conducted by Nireeksha, a theatre group headed by Rajarajeswari and Sudhi, based in Trivandrum. They conducted separate sessions for the two batches on 4th of January to 6th of January for the 2nd year mentees and from 15th February to 17th February for the First year mentees. which helped the students become better equipped at communication and body imaging.

Mentees had several informal group sessions where they were encouraged to come up with new ideas about programmes to be conducted for them as well as programs which will help inculcate qualities of leadership in them. So as per their suggestions, they started a news magazine which was released by Mr. Sambath, Member of Parliament, on 27/02/2019. A campaign named "Life Matters" was also inaugurated by the MP on the occasion. This campaign was the response of our mentees to the increasing number of suicides among the students of our college.

The whole campaign is designed by the mentees and it includes class campaigns, short plays, poster designing and similar programmes. Internal mentoring happened at three levels, as a formal big group, as smaller mentor-mentee formal groups and informal small groups. Formal big group meetings were held with most of the mentors and mentees present, along with the coordinator. Formal mentor-mentee meetings were conducted and discussions done on improving their social skills. Tasks were assigned to the mentees and feedback on programmes conducted were collected orally.

Informal meetings, mostly between a mentor and a mentee were also an important component of this programme. It was mostly personal in nature and helped create a stronger bond between the mentor and the mentee. Another aspect of the mentoring programme to be mentioned in this report is the manner in which we have been selecting students for camps held in other colleges. It is a democratic process where mentees are encouraged to play an active role in the selection, thereby learning to make responsible decisions and choices in life. A workshop on film making followed by a competition to encourage mentees to capture videos of their alma mater was conducted. Another programme was conducted on

March 8th, International Women's day. WWS programme has seen active participation and involvement from both the mentors and mentees throughout the academic year.
