Action taken Report based on the feedback on curriculum

- 1. The department has conducted several meetings with students, parents, alumni, teachers and employers over the years starting from 2016-17 to 2020-21. As per the feedback received through these interactions with the stakeholders, it is suggested to incorporate recent advances in the curriculum.
- 2. It is proposed to reduce some practical sessions to complete the portions within the stipulated time.
- 3. On the basis of feedback from students regarding university examination, the Department has approached the Syndicate members of the university and suggested to schedule examinations after taking into consideration the number of working days proposed and practiced.
- 4. It is decided to conduct more curriculum-oriented activities like Seminars, Expert talks, industrial visits, group discussions, quiz, competitions etc.
- 5. We identified more than half of the student population is satisfied with the curriculum and it is suggested that the teachers must take necessary action to bridge the gap between the curriculum and the students.
- 6. Remedial classes and peer teaching were practiced during off hours and substitution classes were also conducted.
- 7. As the syllabus is more tedious and heavier, it is difficult to complete it within the prescribed time(especially during unavoidable situations like natural calamities and epidemics)through direct teaching methods. We tried to explain the situation to the members of Board of Studies, Academic council, Senate and Syndicate members of the University and suggested to plan the evaluation process through written, practical and viva voce examination only after the completion of the syllabus.
- 8. Conducted seminar sessions to help the students to identify the opportunities related to pursue higher studies and jobs related to their subject.
