
CHEMISTRY





The Course content builds up research aptitude and opportunities for research among students 11 responses




The Course content helps the students in building up language skills, technological skills and course related skills



The syllabus is designed instilling interest for higher studies in the subject 11 responses




The Curriculum is structured ensuring job prospects of students 11 responses






