Action taken Report based on the feedback on curriculum


The department of Commerce conducted regular feedback collection on curriculum from students, alumni, teachers, parents, and employers on each academic year through PTA meetings, alumni meetings, and survey on curriculum using standard questionnaires on curriculum. The responses are regularly analyzed by the teachers and take initiatives to make changes on syllabus according to the feedback.

Suggestions and responses:

1. It is true that curriculum is updated with recent advances in the subject but it should also address and give prominence to issues like Gender, Environment, Sustainability, Human Values and Professional Ethics.
2. There is no freedom to effect modifications in the Curriculum for the benefit of students because the activities like talk and interaction with the experts in the concerned field, industrial visits, group discussions, quizcompetitions etc. need to be included and there is a need to have sufficient time to carry out these activities effectively. So, we have reported the same to the Board of Studies and have included online interaction with the national and international experts.
3. As suggested by the students, test papers were conducted, revision questions and notes were frequently posted in the google class room.
4. Regular PTA meetings have been conducted from 2016-17 to 2020-21. Feedback and suggestions are promptly submitted to the Board of Studies, University of Kerala.

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
