Action taken Report based on the feedback on curriculum

- 1. The Department of Economics has conducted PTA meetings of various batches on a regular basis from 2016-17 to 2020-21. The department also collected feedback on curriculum from the students, parents, teachers, alumni, and employers through survey using questionnaires. An analysis of the feedback obtained from parents and alumnigave the input that less than 10% of parents and almost 13% of alumni favoured a revised curriculum, which is more equipped for job opportunities and competent enough to prepare students in earning employment. This was later discussed in the department meeting and faculty members decided to present this matter in the academic body of Kerala University.
- 2. The alumni of our college opined that student should be provided opportunities to listen to invited talks from eminent personalities in their respective fields. Taking this into account, the faculty decided to focus on conducting webinars, debates and invited talks in days to come.
- 3. From students' feedback, it was observed that many aremuch concernedregarding the introduction of the paper "Informatics and Applied Econometrics" at UG level. The faculty members approached the matter seriously and decided to mention the matter to the Board of Studies. Teachers' lesser involvement in curriculum planning and revision that benefitthe students was another concern that came across which was later mentioned to the higher authority.
