### Action taken Report based on the feedback on curriculum

Mathematics department conducted regular PTA meetings of each batch and collected the responses of students and parents regarding the curriculum followed. Department also collected feedback on curriculum from teachers, students, alumni, and employers through survey method using standard questionnaires. The data received through PTA meetings and survey are analysed, and the suggestions received are listed below:

1. Lack of time to complete the topics prescribed in the syllabus in an effective manner
2. Dissatisfied with some contents of the syllabi as they do not meet the requirements of the curriculum
3. The curriculum should be revised in accordance with the emerging fields in science and technology.
4. Curriculum should be structured in such a way that it should help the students acquire fundamentals of their subject and also make them interested in it.
5. Curriculum should be revised in such a way that it should make the student competent with respect to the concepts, theories and practical knowledge in the subject. It should also incorporate recent advances in the subject.
6. Enough freedom to be given to effect modifications in the Curriculum for the benefit of students
7. The department has informed the feedback to the Board of Studies, University of Kerala and demanded updating syllabus as per the latest needs in academia.

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
