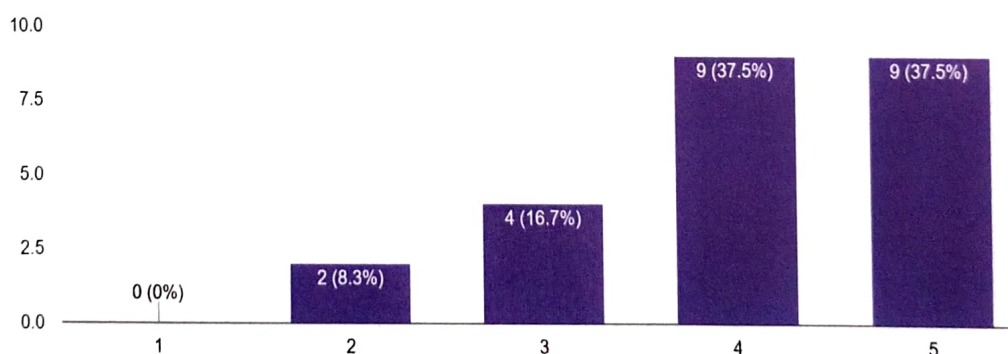
### 1. The Curriculum has created interest in you for pursuing higher studies

0% have graded it as Poor



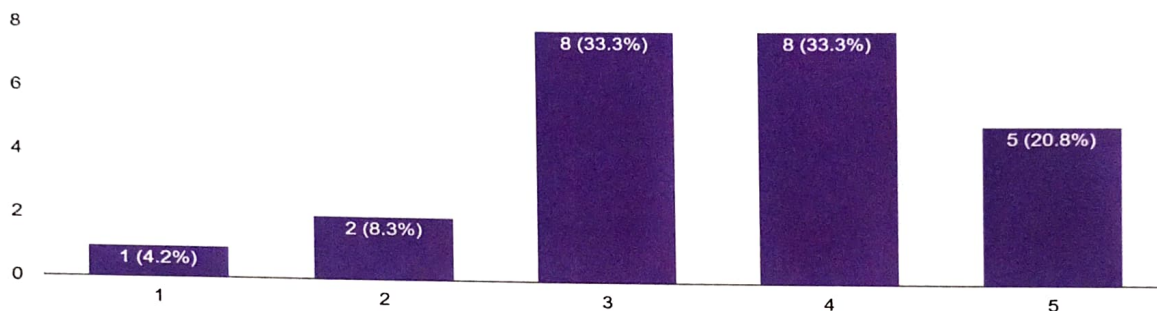
### 2. The Curriculum has made you competent in communicative skills, technical skills and knowledge in the subject

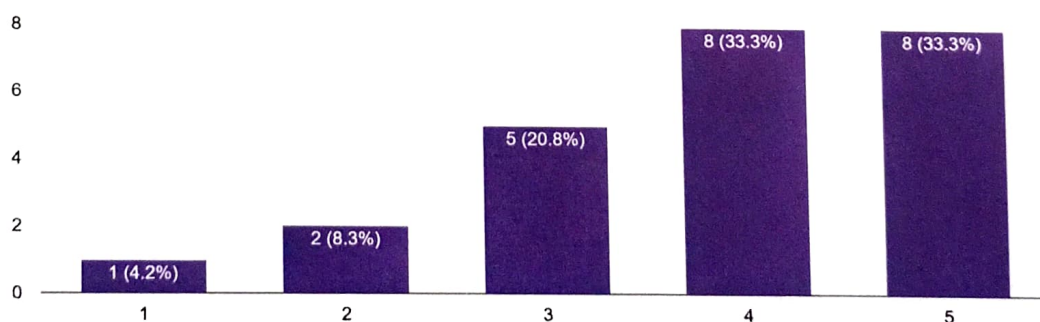

3. The Programme has helped you in acquiring life skills and personality development.

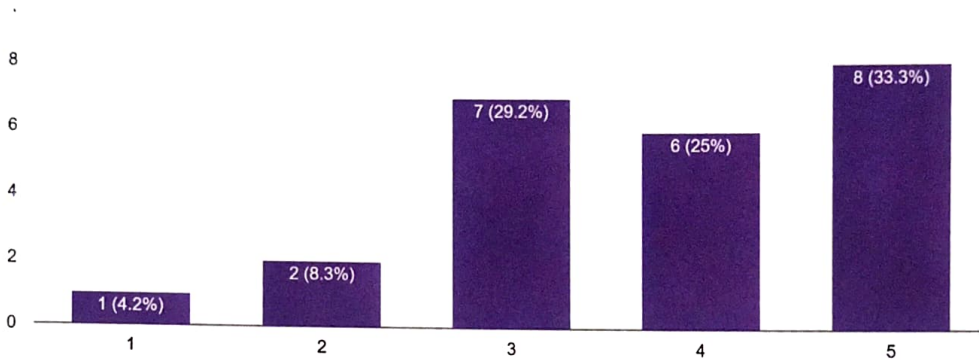

4. The Curriculum included activities like Seminars, guest lectures, industrial visits, group discussions, quiz, competitions, Summer School etc

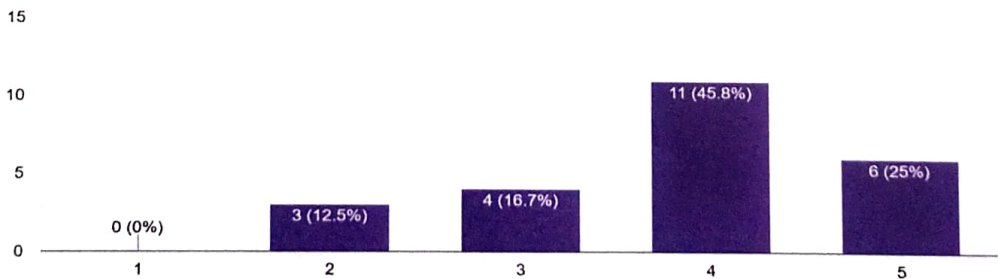

 0% have graded it as Poor



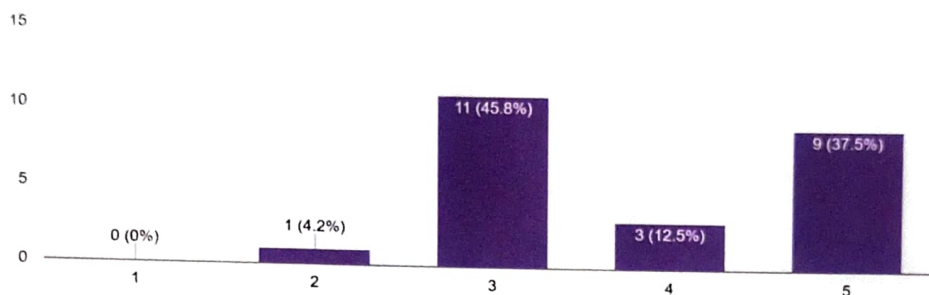

4.2% have grade it as below average, 0% have graded it as Poor



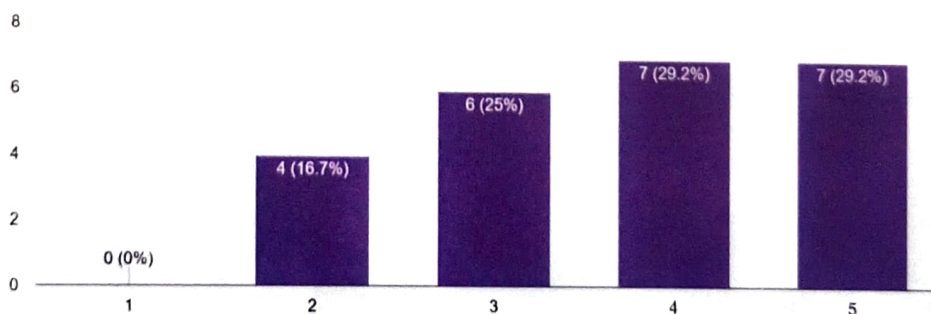
7. Portions in the syllabus was completed within the allotted time period

0% have graded it as Poor



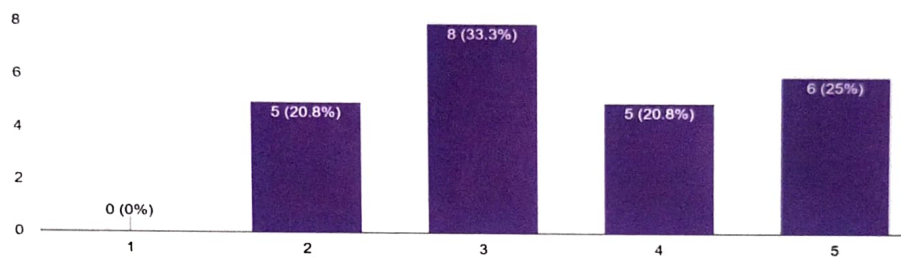

20.8% have grade it as below average, 0% have graded it as Poor

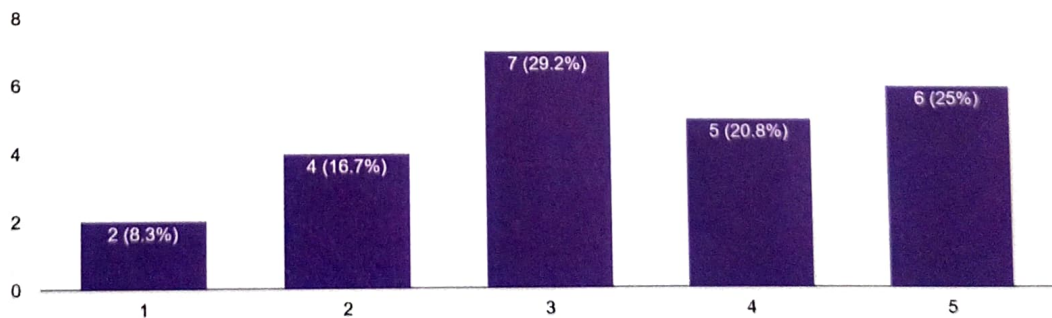


9. The programme of study has made you competent in earning employment
