Action taken Report based on the feedback on curriculum

1. As per the feedback and suggestions received from students, teachers, parents and Alumni of our Department, teachers submitted a representation in the Board of Studies meeting to revise the syllabus of BA Political Science CBCSS incorporating innovative courses suitable for current academic environment. The Chairman responded positively and included the same in the agenda. The members also extended positive response to the proposal and decided to carry out syllabus revision without delay.
2. Due to the unusual circumstances brought about by Covid 19, the department gave importance to conduct Invited talks on topics of current importance to students through the online platform Google Meet.
3. As per the request put forth by parents in the PTA meetings held for S3 and S5 students favouring Invited Talks on relevant topics, the Department took initiative in conducting a number of lectures by eminent personalities in various fields. The department conducted an online lecture on "Women and Social Movement" on 14 March 2021 via Google Meet. Dr. Bushra Beegum, Director, Centre for Women's Studies, University of Kerala gave the key-note address, where she discussed the importance of Women's participation at various levels – local, regional, national and global. The speaker also posited that authentic social development efforts should involve the full participation of women in each country.
4. On 22 March 2021, an online talk was given by Dr. Reinhart Philip, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, University of Kerala on "Water: A Primal of Global Commons".
5. A National Webinar was conducted on the topic "The New Education Policy" which was inaugurated by Prof. Dr. B. Mohanan Pillai, Former Head, International Relations, University of Pondicherry. The pros and cons of the policy were discussed in detail and the seminar was enriched by the responses from the part of the students.
6. Days of importance like Constitution Day and Youth Day were commemorated with special invited talks.
7. Similar initiatives were taken during the academic years 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 as well.
