### **Action taken Report based on the feedback on curriculum**

Regular meetings and survey with students, parents and alumni members were conducted every academic year from 2016-17 to 2020-21. The following points have been suggested. All these suggestions have been forwarded to the Board of Studies, University of Kerala.

1. The syllabus should be completed within the allotted time frame work and students should get enough time for exam preparation.
2. Course content should impart knowledge and aptitude in students. Suggestions are forwarded to college council as well as Board of Studies.
3. It is suggested that the curriculum should also be enriched with content for imparting soft skills to students. It should be one that promotes research aptitude and enthusiasm and should address the sensitive issues in the society and it should not be a burden for students as well as teachers. Suggestions are forwarded to the Board of Studies.
4. It is suggested that more communicative and life skill programmes should be included along with the prevailing curriculum.
5. Group discussions, competitive exam training, mock interviews, Research Lab visits, should also be a part of curriculum. The report has been discussed with the Board of Studies for updating the existing curriculum further. Department meeting has been carried out to discuss the matter and decided to conduct seminar on career opportunities, and to suggest college council to implement training courses in soft skills.



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
