

Brief report of the functioning of Sree Narayana College during 2020-21

The classes for the academic year 2020-21 began on June 1, 2020. Due to the pandemic, teachers were instructed to conduct online classes .A meeting of the College Council was convened to discuss the plan of action for the year. Academic calendar was prepared and the Teachers' were instructed to submit the report of online classes on a weekly basis regularly.

Presently, there are 65 teaching staff members (18 males and 47females), of which 45 possess Ph.D. as their highest degree, and 26 with M.Phil degree as. highest degree.

Admissions to the UG and PG courses this academic year were carried out by the online procedure of the University. The student strength for the year was 2033 (684males and 1349 females) for UG courses and 140(18 males and 122 females) for PG courses. Offline classes were conducted for each batch as per the instructions of the Government strictly adhering to the Covid protocols.A Covid cell was formed in the college under the convenorship of Dr.Manu Remakant, Head,Department of English.

Noteworthy achievements of the college during the academic year 20120-21 are listed below:. InthefinalyearUGexaminationsduringJune 2020 two first ranks and one second rank for UG and one fourth rank for PG rank iwere secured by students.

The activities of the NSS volunteers and NCC cadets were very commendable and brought wide publicity to the college in print and electronic media. The NSS unit engaged in organic forming in thecampus. A whatsapp group for retired teaching and non-teaching staff was started this year.
