## **Report of the functioning of Sree Narayana College during 2017-18**

The classes for the academic year 2017-18 began on June 1, 2017. A council meeting was held to discuss the plan of action for the year. Academic calendar was prepared and Teacher's work diary was distributed to all teachers like in the previous years. There were 192 working days in the college during 2017-18.

The college has 63 teaching staff (14 males and 49 females) of which 35 possess Ph.D as their highest degree, 11 with M. Phil degree, and 17 post-graduates.

Admission to UG and PG classes was carried out by the online procedure of the University. Student strength for the year was 1973 (626 boys and 1347 girls). The first-year students of all classes were given an orientation about the rules and regulations to be followed in the college and about various aspects regarding their course of study during the "Know Your College" programme organised by the IQAC.

In the final year UG exams of April 2017, Nevin Sulthan of III BA Sociology secured first rank in the Kerala University. Greeshma K. of III B.Sc Psychology and Aryasree S. of III BA Political Science secured University third ranks in their courses. Krishnapriya P. S. got fourth rank in BA Political Science examination, University of Kerala.

Two students - Priya Prakashan, II Semester MA English, and Shylaja S. (2015 batch) MA English cleared UGC-NET in English. Anjali P of III year B.Sc. Geology cleared the NET of Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai and got admission for PG course there. Suchitra Devi S., Head, Dept. of Economics, was awarded Ph.D this year. Dr. Swapna Gopinath, Dept. of English, is pursuing her Post-doctoral programme in English of UGC at Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai. Sreenish T. V., Assistant Professor, Dept. of Political Science, received the Best Programme Officer Award from the National Service Scheme Cell, University of Kerala for the year of 2017-18 for his exemplary services through NSS. Dhanya S. R., Assistant Professor, Dept. of Mathematics, submitted her Ph.D. thesis to University of Kerala this year.

Six students who had been working under the supervision of faculty members of our college submitted their Ph.D theses this year. Nine teachers attended refresher/orientation/short-term courses during 2017-18. Teachers actively engaged in research activities and attended various seminars/workshops/conferences.

All clubs and committees of the college actively functioned during the year. Most of the commemorative days and days of international significance were celebrated in the college in a befitting manner. World Environment Day, National Science day, World Ozone day and World Wetlands day were celebrated with the financial help of KSCSTE. Onam and Christmas were celebrated by all teachers and students.

Spectrum-2018, the annual academic seminar series of the college was organized from February 20 to March 8, 2018 in the college seminar hall by the PTA. There was active participation of students from other colleges along with our students. A total of 104 papers (18 from subject experts and 86 from students) were presented during this academic event. PTA of the college distributed cash awards to meritorious students of previous academic year.

College Union Elections were held in the parliamentary mode during 2017-18. Nishanth J. R. of II DC Mathematics was elected as the Chairman of the College Union. The union actively functioned for the benefit of all students and various programmes were organized by the union this year. There was an appreciable participation from the college for the Kerala University Youth Festival held at Kollam in March 2018.

The activities of the NSS volunteers and NCC cadets were very commendable and brought wide publicity to the college in print and electronic media. They also engaged themselves in farming of organic vegetables in the campus and their effort was appreciated by being selected as the second best institutional vegetable garden of the state.

The Principal, teaching and non-teaching staff, and the students acknowledge the support received from the Management in all facets of development of our college.
